## Easy Read Writing

- Short sentences with no contractions.
- Minimal commas and slang.
- Avoid implied meaning by clearly identifying and explaining important topics.
- **Bold** words with extra meaning and explain this in a glossary.
- Guide understanding by ordering content and repeating ideas.
- And . . .?

#### **Sex Characteristics**

**Sex characteristics** are made up of things in your body:

- → Your genitals which are your private parts between your legs.
- → Your reproductive organs which are inside your body.
- → Your hormones which you cannot see but control body changes.
- → Your chromosomes which you cannot see but are in your DNA.

You are born with your sex characteristics. Some of your sex characteristics also grow or change during puberty.



### **Pictures**


- Explain content and meaning of text. Consider:
  - Showing ideas and not assuming knowledge.
  - Using less visual detail.
  - Having labels/arrows.
  - Showing diversity.
  - If need 1 detailed picture or many in a sequence.
  - Having layouts that leave empty space.

Make sure a condom is on correctly so you and your partners are safer from infections. You can practice putting a condom on. check condom expiry pinch tip of condom roll condom down open condom put lube on sexual activity slide off condom put in bin



### Animation

- Select specific pictures that match and clarify meaning.
- Balance diversity and repetition.
- Use less and slow movement.
- Consider a trauma-informed practice when selecting pictures.
- More pictures needed than print (about 1 to 3 per sentence).
- Have less transitions.
- Pictures do not need labels.





### Sound

- Prepare script in Easy English.
- Match nature of voiceover artist's tone with content.
- Slower than conversation speaking speed.
- Consider pronunciation to enhance understanding.
- Use obvious pauses for punctuation.
- Consider having only one voiceover artist per video.
  - If more: Have one voice speaking at a time.
- Balance speaking and silence:
  - Simple soft instrumental music can fill silence and suggest mood.


## **Closed Captions**

- Have closed captions present for all spoken content, even if written on screen.
- Support comprehension by presenting closed captions in chunks of meaning.
- Use full stops after headings to show pauses.
- Format listed content to make listing obvious.
- Ensure compound words are shown on the same closed caption line (such as "sexual health service").
- Limit the need for rapid reading:
  - Reduce rapid changing of closed caption lines. Could have partial sentences shown instead of 1 or 2 words.


