The program is designed to give graduates a head start in WA Health by developing their skills and abilities based on their academic background and areas of personal and professional interest.

Who are we looking for?

- Graduates interested in a career in WA Health and working with one of the State's largest employers.
- Well-rounded graduates who are innovative thinkers and self-motivated high performers.
- Graduates who are good communicators; able to work in a team; and show a commitment to learning and developing their skills.

What does the program offer Aboriginal graduates?

- A 12 month paid contract with WA Health.

Am I eligible for an Aboriginal Graduate Officer position?

To apply for an Aboriginal Graduate Officer position you need to:

- 1. Be Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.
- 2. Have completed your degree in 2017 or plan to complete it in 2018.
- 3. Have a degree issued from a recognised university.
