Can you confirm if the bone putty used in an ORIF as a bone graft substitute should be coded as a bone graft?

Α.

Clinical advice is that bone putty is synthetic and not harvested from patient or donor. Therefore bone graft should not be coded.

DECISION

Bone graft should not be assigned for bone putty as it is a synthetic substance and is inherent in the procedure performed. This query will be submitted to the ACCD.
