0719/26 Bone anchored hearing aid replacement

ACCD Coding Rule *Removal of bone anchored hearing aid (BAHA)* (Ref No: Q3118) was retired on 30 June 2019.

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Eleventh Edition (effective 1 July 2019) new ACHI codes were created for bone anchored hearing aid adjustment and removal.

A patient had the abutment of a Bone Anchored Hearing Aid replaced; however, we can't seem to find a code for the removal of the existing abutment. Can you suggest what code or codes we could use?

A.

Assign 92202-00 [1908] Removal of a therapeutic device NEC. If the abutment is being replaced then assign the code 45797-00 [1697] Osseointegration procedure, fixation of transcutaneous abutment for attachment of bone anchored hearing aid (BAHA).

DECISION

Assign 92202-00 [1908] Removal of a therapeutic device NEC. If the abutment is being replaced then assign the code 45797-00 [1697] Osseointegration procedure, fixation of transcutaneous abutment for attachment of bone anchored hearing aid (BAHA).
