0719/36 Elevated troponin

WA Coding Rule 0712/02 *Elevated troponin* is retired.

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Seventh Edition (effective 1 July 2010) an ICD-10-AM Index entry was created for abnormal troponin serum level. This change was inadvertently missed in the 2018 review of WA Coding Rules.

DECISION

WA Coding Rule 0712/02 Elevated troponin is retired.

Can you please confirm that elevated troponin is now coded to R74.8 *Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes*?

A.

Abnormal level of troponin is listed in the description under R74.8 Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes. This was a 7th edition change.

Coders should ignore any previous advice on how to code elevated troponin and code to R74.8 Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes.

DECISION

Elevated Troponin should be coded to R74.8 Abnormal levels of other serum enzymes.
