0719/41 Immunisation in obstetrics

ACCD Coding Rule Immunisation in obstetrics (Ref No: Q3200) was retired on 30 June 2019.

In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Eleventh Edition (effective 1 July 2019), classification instructions for immunisation were added to ACS 1500 *Diagnosis Sequencing in Obstetric Episodes of Care*.

WA Coding Rule 1116/05 *Immunisation in obstetrics* is superseded by ACCD Coding Rule *Immunisation in a delivery episode of care* (Ref No: Q3200) effective 1 January 2018; (log in to view on the ACCD CLIP portal).

DECISION

WA Coding Rule 1116/05 Immunisation in obstetrics is retired.

Q.

Should routine immunisations in obstetric patients (e.g. MMR) be coded?

Α.

Immunisations (e.g. MMR) should not be coded as per ACS 0042 *Procedures normally not coded*, which states drug therapy is not coded unless it is the principal treatment in a same day admission.

DECISION

Procedure codes or Z codes for MMR and other vaccinations should not be coded.
