ACCD Coding Rule *Tenth Edition FAQs Part 1: Revision of Type 1 and Type 2 Excludes Notes* (Ref No: TN1248) was retired on 30 June 2019.

Coders should be guided by the Conventions used in the ICD-10-AM Tabular List.

Neurogenic Bladder due to spinal cord lesion should be assigned the following codes:

G95.8 Other specified diseases of spinal cord

N31.9 Neurogenic Bladder NOS

#### **DECISION**

Assign code G95.8 Other specified diseases of spinal cord.

N31.9 Neurogenic Bladder NOS can be added to fully describe the disease picture (as per ACS 0002).
