In ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Twelfth Edition, new ACHI blocks have been created for Cell therapies and Gene therapies, these include Natural Killer T-cells. An Includes note for T-cells NOS and Tumour-infiltrating lymphocyte (TIL) therapy has also been added to 13706-04 [1893].

What is the procedure code for patients admitted for infusion of Killer T-Cells?

Possible codes: 13706-04 [1893] Administration of leukocytes and 13706-10 [802] Allogenic bone marrow or stem cell transplantation, other donor, with in vitro processing

Α.

Killer T-cells (lymphocytes) are infused as they target abnormal cells (cancer). Follow the index pathway:

Infusion

-leukocyte and assign 13706-04 [1893] Administration of leukocytes.

DECISION

Assign 13706-04 [1893] Administration of leukocytes for infusion of Killer T-Cells.
