Important dates for Nursing & Midwife graduates applying for positions starting in July – Dec 2022

11 Feb 2022

21 Feb 2022

8 March 2022

GradConnect applications close @ **12 pm** (midday) Perth Time

LATE APPLICATIONS CANNOT BE CONSIDERED

8 March – 8 April 2022

First Round selection processes commence. Your application will be sent to your first preference only. Hospitals and health services will review applications and determine if you will be shortlisted. You will be contacted during this time by your first preference health service only if you have been short listed for an interview. Referee checks also occur during this period.

- Do not contact the site of your preference for an update to your application
- Most health services fill their vacancies during first round
- Health Services determine their own dates for application and interview assessment within the above timeframe

11 April 2022

First Round offers are made directly to successful applicants via GradConnect @ 3pm. You will need to login to your application. If you have been made an offer you will see “offer made”. If you do not see “offer made” you have been unsuccessful. Successful applicants will also receive an email of offer at this time.

- Requests for feedback on applications need to be directed to the site of your first preference no later than 10 September.

14 April 2022

Successful applicants must accept or decline all offers online by 12pm. If you do not accept or decline your offer by this deadline, your offer will be retracted and offered to the next ranked applicant.

19 – 29 April 2022

If your application is unsuccessful after first round it **may** be sent to your second or third site preference **only** if vacancies still exist at those sites. Hospitals and health services with existing vacancies will review applications and determine if you will be shortlisted. You will be contacted during this time **only** if you have been short listed for an interview. Referee checks also occur during this period.

- Do not contact the site of your preferences for an update to your application

29 April 2022

Last date to request feedback. A formal feedback request via email to be directed to site of first preference.

03 May 2022

Mid Round offers are made directly to successful applicants via GradConnect at 3pm. You will need to login to your application. If you have been made an offer you will see “offer made”. If you do not see “offer made” you have been unsuccessful. Successful applicants will also receive an email of offer at this time.

06 May 2022

Successful applicants must accept or decline all offers online by 12pm. If you do not accept or decline your offer by this deadline, your offer will be retracted and offered to the next ranked applicant.

09 May – 20 May 2022

Remaining applicants will be made available to any Hospitals and health services with positions remaining.

23 May 2022

Unsuccessful applicants will be notified via email that the recruitment process has closed. The pool remains open. Please see below:



- The GradConnect recruitment pool is open for six months from the opening date.
- Health sites can go back to their application pools during this time to fill a vacancy should an applicant decline their offer of employment or do not meet eligibility requirements in time for their start date.
- Withdrawing your application will mean you are no longer eligible for these opportunities when they arise.
