
Acknowledgement of Traditional Land Owners



- Our programs will build your confidence using the knowledge that you have gained in your undergraduate or vocational program, to facilitate your transition from beginner to competent nurse.

- Recruit for Osborne Park and Sir Charles Gairdner Hospitals
- 12-month contract
- 4 intakes in the upcoming recruitment process for EN's & RN's :


August 2024 or October 2024 & February 2025 or April 2025

- 2 x 6-month rotations across SCGH or OPH or combination of both sites
- 12-month RN theatre program available at SCGH & OPH August 2024 & February 2025 intakes only
- 6 month or 12-month RN Emergency Department program available at SCGH August 2024 & February 2025 intakes only
- ALL wards and speciality areas at both sites support NQN rotations (ICU, CCU, CVIL, Homelink, Outpatients etc)

Program Details continued ...

- Supported supernumerary days each rotation
- Expert support from Graduate Program staff development nurses (GPS) as well as ward-based staff development nurses
- Comprehensive Education Program, including clinical development seminars, graduate and interprofessional simulations, and professional development study days






Graduate program SDN's (GPS)

The Need to Learn With Support: GPS – there to support you on the floor

- Clinical supervision, support and facilitation of clinical skill acquisition
- Application of theory to practice and fostering critical thinking
- Liaising closely with the staff in the clinical setting to provide appropriate learning opportunities and liaising with other suitable clinical staff that may assess particular aspects of your clinical practice
- Facilitation graduate specific induction, Clinical Development Seminars and Professional Development study days

5 bay recovery area for Local and General anaesthetic post procedure care




Includes 3 Interventional rooms (that treat all areas other than neuro and cardiac).

About Osborne Park Hospital (OPH)

- OPH services include rehabilitation and aged care, younger adult rehabilitation, acute medical and surgical services.

How to Apply...




- 1.Grad Connect opens 15th March
- 2.Select NMHS: SCGOPHCG on grad connect as your 1st preference
- 3.Once GradConnect closes, ALL first round applications are swept to us
- 4.ALL applicants are then sent a questionnaire/survey where they rank start date and site (OPH/ SCGH) (theatre is also a preference at this stage but no other ward or speciality)
- 5.Ward preferences including specialty areas (ED, ICU etc) will happen after interview once you have been successful in gaining a position



Post Program Employment

- Lots of employment opportunities available post program, we want you to stay!!
- At approx. 9 month mark of program a post program employment process will take place for all graduates
- Permanent or Fixed term contracts available




