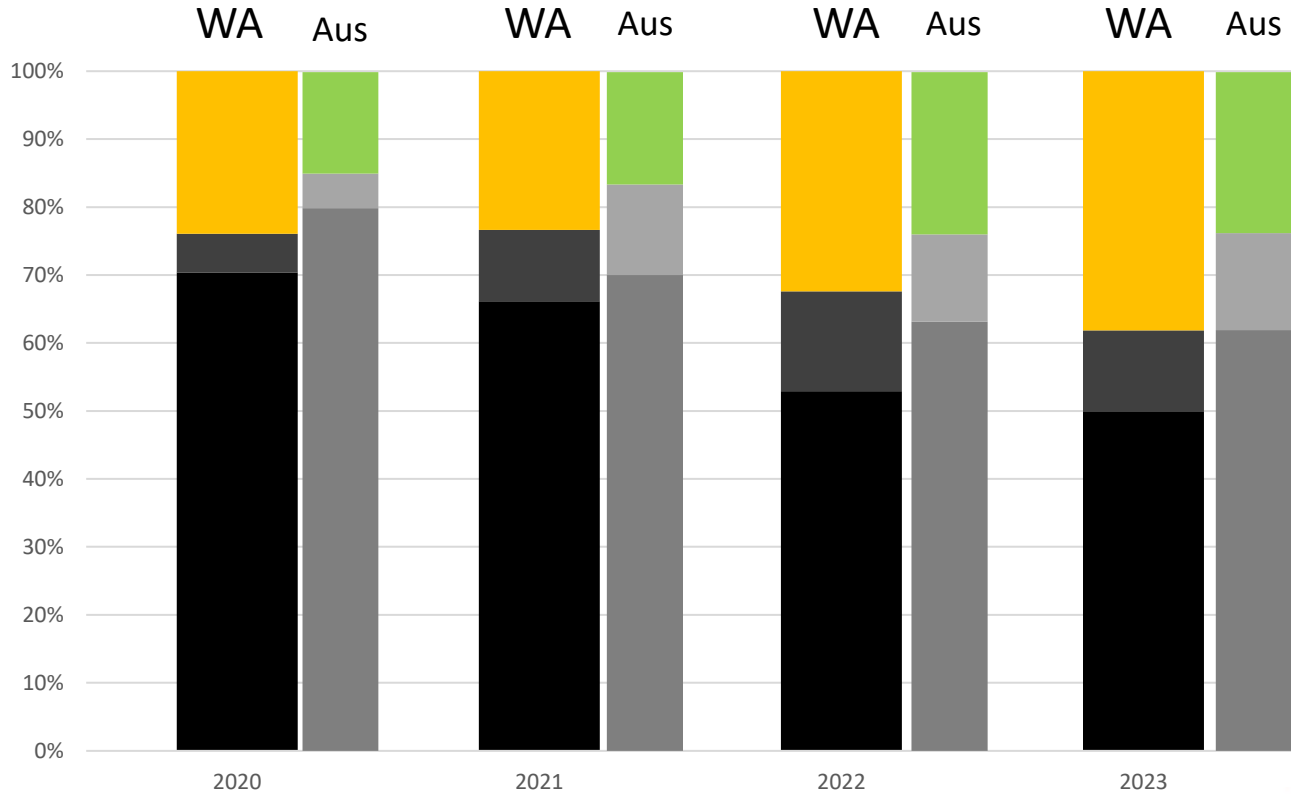

Current

- Commonwealth funded NIP vaccines for eligible patients + state funded influenza vaccines
- Pharmacy can charge a fee to administer
- Non government funded vaccines = user pays +/- private health insurance

From 1 January 2024

- Commonwealth Government will pay pharmacy \$18.85 per NIP vaccine administered
- Non-NIP vaccines - patient pays administration fee plus cost of vaccine
