<b>Fees Cap (for an individual)</b>	<b>Per week</b>	<b>Level 1</b> <b>\$74</b>	<b>Level 2</b> <b>\$168</b>
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Level 1 Fees Caps is based on the Commonwealth Home Care Packages Program which sets the maximum fee payable by a client on a pension or part pension to 17.5% of the pension. The Level 2 Fees Cap is based on the income limit for the Age/Disability Support Pension.
