Referral process	 All referrals require the consent of the patient Completion of <i>Regional Specialist Palliative Care Referral</i> form: referrals within WACHS via e-Referrals referrals from outside WACHS paper based – <i>Regional Specialist Palliative Care Referral</i> form. Urgent referrals by phone call to Clinical Nurse Specialist followed up with completion of <i>Specialist Palliative Care Referral</i> form. Written referrals also accepted. 	
Palliative care discharge criteria	Based on discretion of the Palliative Care team and in discussion with the GP, primary team, the patient and their family/carer.	
Niche services	 Palliative Care Physician review/consultation via Telehealth (monthly).
