Admission criteria	Progressive life-limiting disease (malignant or non-malignant) requiring specialist palliative care that cannot be provided within current setting. Exclusions: <ul style="list-style-type: none">* Wandering confused patients* Violent/aggressive patients or known family members/carers (there is no security on site)* Patients requiring companions* Patients with suicidal ideation* Paediatric patients (up to 16 years of age).
