EN (applicant) completes postregistration qualification application template and submits it to line manager Within 10 working days of receiving post-registration qualification application template, line manager assesses document and makes recommendation to Director of Nursing/Midwifery Director of Nursing/Midwifery (DON/M) Unsuccessful applicants / Area Chief Executive (ACE) delegate At the same time as referring applicant for further development, DON/M writes to reviews the recommendation for endorsement and/or approval within five applicant, explaining why application has working days. Successful applicants The DON/M / ACE delegate reviews the recommendation and either endorses the request for reclassification or seeks further information. Written advice provided to the applicant.
